Registration:

- Students make an appointment for testing & registration in winter, spring, summer, fall sessions.
- All students must have a valid test, fill out student registration form, sign student agreements, and commit to attending a full session.

Fee: \$60.00 Program Fees due on registration day

Testing:

BEST Plus (Basic English Skills Test) – an oral or written test. Students are given a post test at the completion of a class, after 60 hours of class time, or at the tutor's recommendation.

Levels: GLA serves Beginning (Level 1) through Advanced ESL (Level 6).

Skills & Subject Areas:

Listening, speaking, reading, writing, grammar, pronunciation, conversation, and special topics are taught using topic-based survival/job ready English.

Certificate of achievement:

Awarded at the completion of the session after post testing successfully in order to move up to the next level.
